<p>4</p> <p>EXCELLENT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tells the opposite of all the adjectives correctly. • Answers all the questions grammatically correct. • Speaks clearly and makes no mistake. • Produces a very good speech at an appropriate pace.
<p>3</p> <p>RIGHT ON TRACK</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tells the opposite of most adjectives correctly. • Answers most questions grammatically correct. • Speaks clearly almost all of the time and makes occasional mistakes on the pronunciation of the words. • Produces a good speech at an appropriate pace.
<p>2</p> <p>NEEDS IMPROVEMENT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tells the opposite of a few adjectives correctly. • Answers few questions grammatically correct. • The clarity of speech is sufficient but some words are pronounced incorrectly. • Produces a satisfactory speech with pauses and hesitations.
<p>1</p> <p>CAN DO BETTER</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can't tell the opposite of adjectives correctly. • Can't answer the questions grammatically correct. • Not very clear. Often whispers and pronounces words incorrectly. • Reveals difficulties in producing a speech: constant pauses, hesitations and slow pace.
<p>RESULT</p>
